

## Oxeye Daisy - 1


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## Materials and equipment:

Size 20 thread, 14 size 9 or 11 beads 2 shuttles and the usual tatting equipment.

## Abbreviations:

R. $=$ Ring, $B=$ bead, $\mathrm{cl}=$ close ring, RW = reverse work, $\mathrm{CH} .=$ chain

String the beads then wind about 1 metre, with 4 of the beads, on the shuttle, leaving
 11 beads on the ball thread
Petals - see Fig 1
*R.A Bring a bead (from the shuttle) into the ring round your hand $10, \mathrm{~B}, 10, \mathrm{cl}, \mathrm{RW}$
CH. 1, B, 1**
Repeat from * to ** twice more then
\#R.D Bring a bead (from the shuttle) into the ring round your hand
$10, \mathrm{~B}, 10, \mathrm{cl}, \mathrm{RW}$

## Centre of the flower - See Fig 2

CH. Work a shoe-lace-trick then continue:
$1,(B, 1) \times 7$.
Tension (pull up) the chain to a tight curve then cut and tie to the base of ring A

## Oxeye Daisy 2

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## Materials and equipment:

Size 20 thread, 18 size 9 or 11 beads 2 shuttles and the usual tatting equipment.

## Abbreviations:

R. = Ring, $\mathrm{B}=$ bead, $\mathrm{cl}=$ close ring, RW = reverse work, $\mathrm{CH} .=$ chain

String the beads then wind about 2 metres, with 15 of the beads, on the shuttle, leaving 3 beads on the ball thread

## Petals - see Fig 1


*R.A Bring a bead (from the shuttle) into the ring round your hand $10, \mathrm{~B}, 10, \mathrm{cl}, \mathrm{RW}$
CH. $1, \mathrm{~B}, 1^{* *}$
Repeat from * to ** twice more then
\#R.D Bring a bead (from the shuttle) into the ring round your hand 10, B, 10, cl, RW
CH. 2, RW\#\#
Repeat from \# to \#\# four more times omitting the RW on the final repeat Join to the base of ring A Do not cut.


## Centre of the flower - see Fig 2

Unwind about 12 inches from the ball and wind it onto the second shuttle
Fold rings E, F, G and H behind rings $\mathrm{A}, \mathrm{B}, \mathrm{C}$ and D
Turn work over
Using shuttle 2 chain $1,(B, 1) \times 7$
Tension the chain into a curve.
Cut and tie to the base of ring D.
Tat a stem in lock chain (as in the picture above) or in $5: 5$ sets or 1:1 pearl tatting.

## Oxeye Daisy 3

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## Materials and equipment:

Size 20 thread, 17 size 9 or 11 beads and the usual tatting equipment.

## Abbreviations:

R. $=$ Ring, $\mathrm{B}=$ bead, $\mathrm{cl}=$ close ring, RW $=$ reverse work, CH. $=$ Chain,,$+=$ join

String the beads then wind about 2 metres, with 7 of the beads, on your shuttle, leaving 10 beads on the ball thread

## Petals - see Fig 1

Bring 1 bead into the ring round your hand before starting each ring.

| R.A | 10, B, 6, p, 4, cl |
| :---: | :---: |
| R.B | 10, B, 6, p, 4, cl, RW |
| CH . | 1, B (from the ball thread), 1, RW |
| R.C | $4,+$ to ring A, $6, ~ B, ~ 6, ~ p, ~ 4, ~ c l ~$ |
| R.D | $4,+$ to ring B, $6, B, 6, p, 4, \mathrm{cl}$, RW |
| CH. | 1, B (from the ball thread), 1, RW |
| R.E | $4,+$ to ring C, 6, B, 6, p, 4, cl |
| R.F | $4,+$ to ring $\mathrm{D}, 6, \mathrm{~B}, 10, \mathrm{cl}, \mathrm{RW}$ |
| CH. | 1, B (from the ball thread), 1, RW |
| R.G | $4,+$ to ring E, 6, B, 10 cl , |

Do not reverse work here but make a shoe-lace-trick so that the ball and shuttle threads change places.


## Centre of the flower - see Fig 2

CH. $\quad 1,(\mathrm{~B}, 1) \times 7$, tension to make the chain curve Cut and tie to the base of rings A and B

Tat a stem in lock chain or in $5: 5$ sets or 1:1 pearl tatting.
