

Adding beads to a long picot

<u>Note:</u> These instructions show this technique between two rings but the same instructions apply if the long picot is between a ring and a chain or two chains.


1) Work the ring as far as the long picot. Pick up the beads onto a crochet hook, and catch up the threads from round your hand




2) Transfer the beads from the crochet hook onto the thread round your hand and pull a little loop through the beads.



3) Secure the loop using a safety pin and adjust the thread to bring the beads close to the last stitch.



4) Work the rest of the ring according to the pattern and close.



5) Work the next ring, following the pattern, as far as the join to the long beaded picot, then carefully remove the safety pin and work a join to the small loop left by the safety pin.

Continue, following the pattern.
